The International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) is a United States export control law that affects the manufacturing, sales and distribution of technology. The purpose of the legislation is to control access to specific types of technology and the associated data in order to prevent the disclosure or transfer of sensitive information to a foreign national.

ITAR implements the AECA. Articles specifically designed or otherwise intended for military end-use are enumerated on the United States Munitions List or the Missile Technology Control Regime Annex and therefore controlled by International Traffic in Arms Regulations which is administered by the Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC) at the State Department.

Our training provides an overview, distributes knowledge, and arranges group exercises. You will be given group exercise case studies with examples from the aerospace industry will be used to help attendees gauge where their QMS's has potential gaps and help meet their specific needs.
